In this position, your responsibilities will include:

- Overseeing the development and coordination of the Metrolinx Accessibility Plan and Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA) implementation plans, and monitoring progress.
- Leading regional multi-agency initiatives to identify and implement improvements to regional (cross-boundary) accessible transit services.
- Coordinating the activities of the Metrolinx Accessibility Advisory Committee.
- Performing the role of Project Manager on selected projects, involving the management of consultants and cross-functional project teams.
- Providing creative analysis and serving as a subject matter expert for issues related to accessible transportation system planning issues.
- Serving as a key point of contact, liaising with stakeholders, municipal partners, and provincial ministries on regional accessible transportation issues.

**Qualifications:**

- Significant knowledge of the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA), accessibility policy environment, specialized and accessible transit service delivery and issues, accessible planning and design, normally attained through completion of a four-year university program in Disability Studies or related subject, or any combination of training, education and experience deemed equivalent.
- Minimum six (6) years experience in the development or delivery of accessible services, including demonstrated experience with, or knowledge of provincial/municipal legislation, policy, and programs related to the needs of people with disabling conditions.
- Knowledge of specialized and accessible transportation service delivery, and the requirements of travellers with disabilities.
- Excellent team leadership, facilitation, and interpersonal skills, as applied to situations with multiple perspectives.
- Knowledge of the theory, principles and practices of project management, including managing contracted assignments or services.
- Solid skills in research, analysis, problem solving, and planning, used in the development of solutions to complex problems.
- Strong written and oral communication skills as applied to presentations, facilitation, report-writing, and participating in committees.
- Proficiency with software applications, including Microsoft Office applications and modeling techniques.
