COMMUNICATION SERIES

2 Day

It's all about Perspective (morning)

Perception is reality; your ability to see the other person's point of view will dictate your ability to supervise effectively. Explore how different perspectives in transit shape the communication process, and how you can turn these conflicting views into an advantage. Apply communication theory to transit situations to influence community and interpersonal perceptions.

Relationship Management (afternoon)

In Supervision, it often comes down to one-on-one discussions. Examine the nature of interpersonal relationships and learn how to apply this knowledge to make you a better Supervisor. Gain insight into building and maintaining relationships with your direct reports, your peers, and even your boss.

Understanding Others (morning)

We all crave understanding, but what are we doing to make those around us feel understood? In Supervision, it's not all about you (or at all about you!). Learn the secrets of listening and how to decipher the message behind the message. Practice techniques that help you leverage the power of listening.

Are you Getting your Message Across? (afternoon)

"I can see you nodding, but are you hearing only 'blah, blah, blah?'" Ensure that what you say is what they hear. Analyze your own communication style in order to utilize your strengths and minimize your weaknesses. Discover how to avoid misunderstandings and the negative consequences that can result.
